**O Clavis David** combines texts from the book of Isaiah, the Psalms, and the writings of Elizabeth Hooton (1600–1672), the first woman to become a Quaker minister. Born in Nottinghamshire, she made several transatlantic crossings to investigate state-sanctioned violence and oppression against Quakers in the American colonies. She was jailed on both sides of the Atlantic and decried the injustices carried out against prisoners.

“O Clavis David” (O Key of David) is a title from Isaiah used in the O Antiphons, describing the Messiah as he who will “lead the prisoners from the prison house.”

## Text

- Hooton I labored to lay before the king the grievances of the innocent, and hither have I come time after time, for equity and for justice.
- Isaiah 22: 22 And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; and he shall open it.
- Hooton Do not join with them that would persecute and wrong the innocent, for if thou dost thou wilt wrong thy one soul.
